
Access to Colorado Bent County 40 Acres (CO_Bent01B)

Entrance 1 is the easiest to access, with existing two track dirt roads.

After about 1.1 mile, you will see a cattle gate (GPS: 38.05218, -103.10476), secured by barb wire. Future property owner will be able to pass the cattle gate and continue on another two track dirt road to the 40 acres land, provided to give the cattle rancher a heads-up. Contact Elegment Land team after closing for cattle rancher's phone number.



Continue on another two track dirt road after the cattle gate for about 0.7 mile to reach Northwest corner of the 40 acres tract (approximate GPS: 38.05236, -103.09199).

Note: the sign at the entrance is for the (nearby) State Trust Land during hunting seasons. It does not apply to this 40 acres private land.



Entrance 2 has no visible dirt road or two track. Might be the most challenging to get to the 40 acres.

Entrance 3 has the old two track dirt road. But with overgrown grass. This is still accessible, but more challenging than Entrance 1.
